

Park Hours: 7:00 AM to 10:00 PM (Sunday-Thursday), 7:00 AM to 11:00 PM (Friday-Saturday)

General Rules:

Dogs:

- Dogs must be on a leash (max. 16 feet) and under owner's control.
- Service animals are permitted.

Trash:

- It must be placed in designated cans.
- Use liners inside pavilion cans and remove and replace the liners after use.
- Please take full cans to the street, (please bring empty cans into South side of pavilion if needed).
- Littering is prohibited.

Prohibited Activities:

- Amplified music
- Golfing
- Profanity/abusive language
- Tree climbing
- Fires outside of designated pits
- Camping
- Alcoholic beverages
- Archery
- Slacklining
- Metal detecting
- Fireworks
- Overnight parking
- Skateboards, skates, scooters on courts
- Smoking/Vaping

Vehicles:

- Allowed only in designated parking lots.
- Not allowed on grass or sidewalks.

Food:

- Cookers, BBQs, etc. must be used on concrete surfaces and cleaned up.
- Do not dump anything harmful on the grass (e.g., cooking oil, coals, salt, hot water).
- No food trucks without committee approval.

Other:

- No nails or tape on pavilion walls or tables.
- Picnic tables must remain with the pavilion they are in.
- No bounce houses without committee approval and liability insurance.

- Power usage is limited.
- Unruly behavior is not permitted.

Reoccurring Activities: Require committee approval for fields, courts, arena, and pavilions.

Pavilion Rules:

Reservations: Required for organized use.

Clean Up:

- The point of contact (POC) for the reservation is responsible for cleaning up after the event.
- Clean and wipe down tables, countertops, and remove all decorations.
- Place all trash in provided trash barrels.
- Empty full liners into larger trash containers and replace them with new liners.
- Sweep/clean floor and all used surfaces.
- Check bathrooms for cleanliness and turn off water.
- Empty and clean fridge if used.

Departure:

- Turn off lights.
- Lock all doors.
- Report any maintenance issues.

Damages:

- Additional charges will be billed for damages or excessive cleanup.

Additional Notes:

- Key for roll-up doors is on the south board (return after use).

Hold Harmless Clause:

To the fullest extent permitted by law, Contractor/Third Party shall hold harmless, defend at its own expense, and indemnify Weber County Service Area # 6 (West Warren Park or Reese Park) its officers, employees, agents, and volunteers, against any and all liability, claims, losses, damages, or expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees, arising from all acts or omissions to act of contractor or its officers, agents, or employees in rendering services under this contract; excluding, however, such liability, claims, losses, damages, or expenses arising from Weber County Service Area # 6 (West Warren Park or Reese Park) sole negligence or willful acts.
